- **Highlight specific focus areas** each year to ensure impactful giving.

The leadership team encompasses geographically diverse North Carolina high school and university students, ensuring broad representation and engagement across the state.



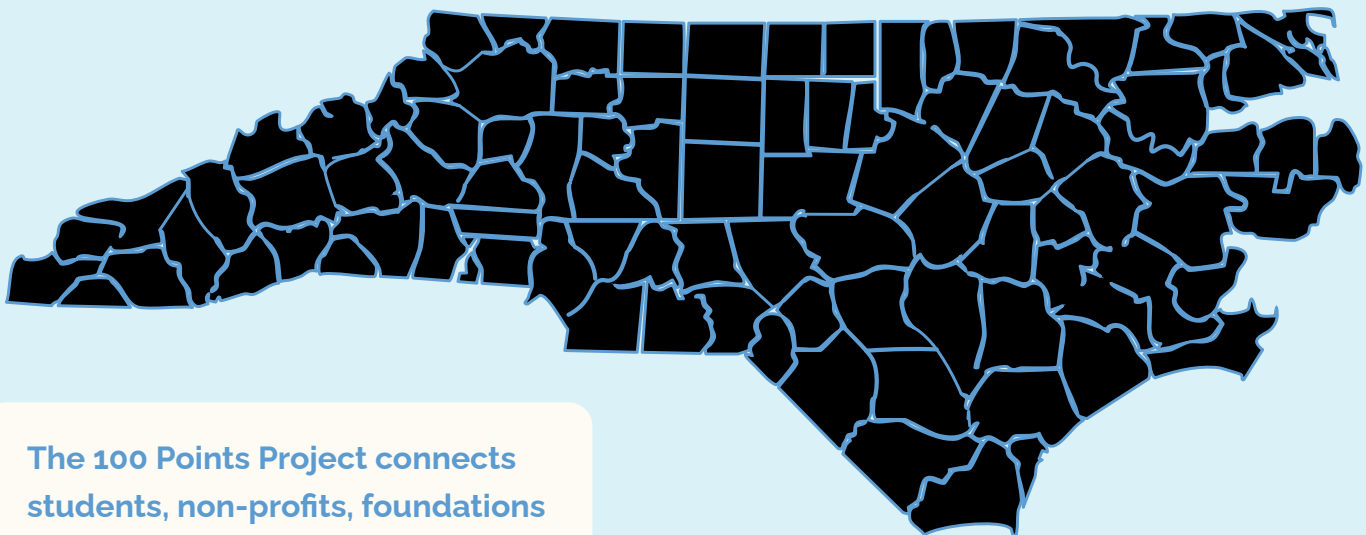
ADVISORY BOARD
